Council Minutes

The City Council of the City of Blooming Grove held a Special-Called meeting on Wednesday, October 15, 2025, at the City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Mayor Ashley Mahone.

Members present were Mayor Ashley Mahone, Council Members Bill Carroll, Renee Watson, Jody Gantt, Sarah Southard, Haley Ehly, City Secretary Carrie Sweeney and Utility Superintendent Rory Evans.

Visitors-

There were no visitors present.

New Business-

Haley Ehly made a motion and Renee Watson seconded to approve Maguire's request for a temporary exception to Article 8.04 "Offenses and Nuisances" in the Blooming Grove Code of Ordinances so they can work on Saturdays. The motion carried.

Councilman Bill Carroll presented to the Council a Water Storage Location Assessment to determine what location would be best for water storage, should the city ever need additional storage capacity. The locations in the assessment included Block K and the Community Garden lot which are both owned by the city, and several lots that are owned by BGISD. Based on the assessment, the Community Garden lot would be the best location for additional water storage. For more detail, please see the assessment that is attached to these minutes.

Haley Ehly made a motion and Sarah Southard seconded to begin the process of putting Block K up for sealed bids. The motion carried.

Discussion Items-

The Council discussed the possibility of entering an interlocal agreement with the City of Frost. The Council agreed that more information would be needed to determine if this arrangement would be beneficial to both cities.

Haley Ehly made a motion and Sarah Southard seconded to adjourn at 6:07 p.m. The motion carried.
